#### **About this Webinar**

The purpose of this webinar is to provide practical guidance on safe packing of mixed loads of batteries for road transport.

This four-hour webinar has been prepared by ABRI with input from the National Transport Commission and members of the Competent Authorities Panel to ensure that the information provided is consistent with the latest version of the ADG.

The Australian Dangerous Goods Code was updated to version 7.7 in July 2020 for implementation October 2020 with a 12-month transition period to follow.
